1ST TAYLOR'S BRIZLINCOAT LULU (63) F 18.11.10

A sweet little girl of only 4 months, perhaps she could be a little larger overall for this stage of her development but she is perfectly formed. Nice head, a moderate wedge with rounded contours, whisker indentation & rounded muzzle. Good nose break in profile, deep chin & level bite. Large cupped ears set wide apart & large expressive eyes of good shape & set. Only young so lots of growing still to do but her body is of medium build with limbs to balance & moderately long tail. Dense coat of a good length but kitteny as befits her age. The overall colour could be richer but the hall light wasn't helping. Black ticking beginning to develop, darker spine line & black tip to the tail. OK facial markings, creamy coloured chin and unmarked chest. Lovely temperament & condition.
