OPEN CLASSES

CORNISH REX ADULT

1ST CC & BOB THOMPSON'S GR CH CHRISAN CALLICO (33 22a) F 19.07.04

A very sweet & gentle girl of 5 years with a lovely feel to her coat. Head a medium wedge narrowing to a rounded muzzle with high cheek bones. Flat skull, rounded brow & almost straight profile. Level bite & firm but shallow chin. Large ears set rather high & oval eyes of medium size. Very elegant, muscular body of medium length carried high on long slender limbs. Long tapering tail with a small bony excrescence at the tip. Soft silken coat, short fine & of an even length on the body with tight ripples. She was a little reserved but easy to handle. Shown in lovely condition & very attractive blue tortie & white colouration to her coat.

2ND THOMPSON'S CH CHRISAN CARA MIA (33 31s) F 25.07.08

A younger girl of only 1½ years from the same household. Head a medium wedge narrowing to a rounded muzzle with high cheek bones. Flat skull, rounded forehead and almost straight profile. Level bite & deep chin but her nose goes over her chin a little. Large well-set ears with a broad base & rounded tips. Rather large eyes that tend to dominate her face. Elegant body carried high on long legs but I would prefer harder muscle on her body. Long tapering tail to balance. Dense silken coat with good depth to the waves. Well-covered apart from a small patch of stud tail. Long whiskers & slightly crinkly eyebrows. Gentle nature if a little wriggly & shown in lovely condition.

OCICAT KITTEN

1ST & BOB APLIN'S MANCHADO KIZZY (73) F 17.11.09 Tawny

A well-grown young kitten of only 4 months & of a good weight for her size. Head a modified wedge longer than it is wide with a slight curve from muzzle to cheek. Reasonably square muzzle that could be a little broader, better when she was alert and puffing out her whisker pads; longer in profile. Very slight dip to the profile and her chin falls away a little, level bite. Large ears with a wide base & gently rounded tips; set at a 45° but closer than an ear base width at present as limited by the breadth of her head. Very expressive large eyes of a full almond shape & angled slightly upwards towards the ears. Well-grown body, muscular & elegant with strong limbs to balance & large oval feet at present. Fairly long, slightly tapering tail. Close-lying coat with a satiny texture developing. Distinct spotting of dark brown spots on a tawny agouti ground with lots of spots giving a "busy" effect at present. Good head markings with a tabby "M" on the forehead, pale colour around the eyes and dark markings on the cheeks. Double broken necklaces on the chest, well-spotted tummy & broken bracelets on the lower limbs. Bull's eye pattern on the flanks. Brick red nose leather rimmed with black, dark brown paw pads & black tip to the tail. A sweet girl who was a little in awe of the occasion but lively in her pen and shown in lovely condition.

BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL NEUTER

BOB FORDHAM'S PR RAJIQUE LAKOTA SPIRIT (76 30) MN 20.03.07

A strong muscular fellow of 3 years. Masculine head, a medium wedge with gently rounded contours. Large nose & broad muzzle. Well-set ears of medium size & oval eyes of a lovely green colour. Long sleek body with strong muscular limbs. Medium length tail that tapers a little. Soft dense coat, the overall colour is a little dark & although the spots are large & have a dark outline they could show a little more contrast with the ground colour. Spotted tummy & ringed tail with a dark tip.

GOODGER'S GR PR SOOSTEE WHITE GOLD (76b 30) MN 09.11.04

A strong handsome blue-eyed boy of 5 years who is very easy to handle. Broad masculine head of medium length though his profile is a fraction straight. Moderately large ears set wide apart & large blue eyes though they could be deeper in colour. Long muscular body with rather long, muscular limbs & slightly tapering tail of medium length. Short soft & dense coat with a lovely feel to the touch. Spotted pattern on an ivory base but the spotting ideally could be more distinct.

SNOW SPOTTED BENGAL NEUTER FEMALE

BOB GOODGER'S GR PR WELLMAR ARAPAHOKIOWA (76a 30) FN 15.03.02

A mature girl of 8 years and looking good for her age. Feminine head, a broad medium wedge with gently rounded contours & deep curve to the profile. Well-fed body with a large tummy! Muscular limbs of medium length & good tail of medium length & even thickness. Soft dense coat clearly spotted with large arrowhead spots on a tan base. Shown in lovely condition & easy to handle, an old favourite of mine.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

AV SLH BREEDERS KITTEN

A super class of kittens & a credit to their breeders – looks good for the future!

1ST DELANEY'S DEENLAY SEULETUNIQUE (13c2) M Blue Point Birman

A well-grown young man of 7 months with lovely type. Broad head with a rounded skull, well-developed cheeks and nose of medium length. Slight dip to the profile, good deep chin and level bite. Wide-set ears of medium size & almost round eyes of a good blue colour. Well-grown body with strong limbs and large feet. Bushy tail to balance. Lovely coat of a silken texture, pale body colour & blue-grey points developing well. Good pure white feet markings. He was sleepy at first and then complained about being handled but wasn't a problem. Shown in excellent condition.

Congratulations to his proud owner/breeder on later becoming Overall Best in Show!

2ND HAMILTON'S PHATPAWS CLUFORT WEGWOOD (66 31a) M Blue Bicoloured Ragdoll

A handsome boy of 8 months & shown in excellent condition. Broad head with a flat plane between the ears and medium length nose. Medium ears set wide apart & pale blue eyes that could be a little larger & more well-opened. Well grown body, long & muscular with strong limbs to balance & bushy tail that could be a little longer. Well-prepared silky coat with a pale body colour contrasting with blue-grey points. White inverted "V" on the face & white patch on his back. Easy to handle with a gentle nature.

3RD HAMILTON'S PHATPAWS INNOCENCE (66 31a) F Blue Bicoloured Ragdoll
A slightly younger kitten of 7 months with lots of coat. Broad head with a flat plane between the ears and well-developed rounded muzzle but very deep dip to the profile. Medium ears set wide apart with lovely long inner streamers & expressive blue eyes. Long body with limbs to balance & lovely bushy tail. Well-prepared coat with a silky texture. Blue-grey points, white inverted "V" on the face and white underparts. A sweet natured girl who was easy to handle and shown in lovely condition.

AV FOREIGN MAIDEN ADULT

1ST BANDY'S TROIKA LA BAYADERE (16a) F Russian Blue

A young girl of only 12 months. Good type with large vertically-set ears, almond-shaped green eyes and prominent whisker pads. Elegant & muscular body with long limbs and long but rather thick tail. Very dense coat, double and plushy though a touch long & could be softer. Even blue coat colour but I would prefer more of a silvery sheen. Gentle girl and easy to handle.

2ND AGGETT'S MAGICAL ELF INSTARDUST (33a 30as) M Devon Rex

A young boy of only 10 months & needing to mature, his head needs to broaden a little. Well-defined whisker break and strong muzzle. Flat skull, rounded brow and quite good stop in profile. Large low-set ears and large oval eyes set on a slight slant. Long neck & deep chest but his body is a little long. Long tapering tail to balance. Very short coat and not long enough to curl properly but does show evidence of rexing. Downy tummy and some guard hairs on his tail.

AV FOREIGN BREEDERS KITTEN

1ST DEAN'S CLANCLINTON CLAQUE TETE (33a 40 15) M Devon Rex

A very cute little boy of only 3½ months. Head a short, quite broad wedge with a short nose. Top of head a little rounded, some stop (can be felt) in profile. Large low-set ears and oval eyes that could be a little larger but set wide apart and on a slant. Well-grown muscular body with elegant limbs and long fine tail. Hardly any coat as yet though well-covered on the backs of his ears and waves beginning on his limbs and tail. Very little coat on the body and slightly harsh to the touch as it is beginning to grow though.

AV FOREIGN NEUTER

1ST HUMMERSTON'S CH & IGR PR CHRISAN CAMELOTT (33 31s) MN

Cornish Rex

A handsome black smoke & white boy of 3½ years with a snooty look & lovely type. Head a medium wedge narrowing to a rounded muzzle with an almost straight profile. Large ears set rather high and medium eyes of good shape & set. Elegant body carried high on slender limbs and long tapering tail. Lovely coat with a silken texture and lovely rexing of tight ripples on the body. Shown in excellent condition & very easy to handle.

1ST LAUGHER'S IGR CH & PR LOHR DAYDREAM BELIEVER (72 45bq)

A sweet girl of 9 years shown in lovely condition with a beautiful coat. Head a short broad wedge with well-set ears of medium size and large eyes expressive eyes. Elegant & muscular body of medium length & size with limbs to balance & small

oval paws. Medium length tail to balance. Short fine & close-lying coat with distinct chocolate ticking. The only one in the class but well-worthy of the first place.
