I was given the task of picking Best Foreign Kitten in the Short-Haired CS Show & my choice was Connie Henderson's Brown Spotted Bengal Wothorpe Gina who has a beautiful coat pattern. I also chose the Best Thai for the Korat Cat Association & the winner was Sarah Williams-Elliss' Thai Lilac girl Thanonwang Elvenstar, a lovely girl with a gorgeous pinky-beige coat tipped with silver.

**SHORT-HAIRED CAT SOCIETY**

**OPEN CLASSES**

**ORIGINAL FOREIGN PREMIER MALE**

GPC EVANS'S GR PR MAIPENRAI DOWJAI (34) MN 20.08.07

A strong muscular boy of only 2 years, very well-grown with a powerful body. Broad masculine head, heart-shaped with good width between & across the eyes and a well-developed muzzle. Slight stop in profile & his nose drops off at the tip. Level bite with lovely teeth and good chin. Large well-set ears with rounded tips though he tended to hold them down. Large well-opened green eyes. Semi-cobby body with limbs to balance & tapering tail, heavier at the base. Lovely quality to his fine close-lying coat. Lots of silver tipping on the extremities, not so well-developed on the body. He made lots of Korat noises but wasn't a problem to handle.

**ORIGINAL FOREIGN PREMIER FEMALE**

GPC DELNEVO & MACRO'S PR CRISPUS SEMOLINA SILKPAWS (33a 40 13)  
FN 04.10.03 Devon Rex

A mature girl of 6½ years. Typical "Pixie" look, head a short broad wedge with high cheek bones, well-defined whisker break and strong muzzle. Flat skull, rounded brow & short nose with a good stop in profile. Level bite with lovely teeth. Muscular body of medium length with limbs & tail to balance. Short dense coat with lovely rexing on the body, very slightly straighter down the spine. Soft coat apart from some harshness down her tail & well-covered apart from a downy tummy. Gentle nature and easy to handle and shown in lovely condition.

RGPC DAY'S PR MAIPENRAI DOC FLOWER (Korat) FN 01.06.08 Korat

A strong well-grown girl of not yet 2 years. Heart-shaped head with good breadth between & across the eyes gently curving to a rounded muzzle. Very slight stop in profile created by a nose bump though it helps her nose drop off. Level bite but her chin could be stronger. Large well-set ears when alert though you have to choose your moment! Large well-opened green eyes. Muscular semi-cobby body with limbs to balance, her tail has a heavy base and is just long enough. Single, fine close-lying

coat of an even blue colour with good silver tipping. Lots of Korat talk when handled but not a problem. Shown in lovely condition.

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN ADULT, MALE**

**BOB DESOLLA'S GR CH BRUNNBACKEN'S SAMBESI (IMP) (23) M 25.03.07**

A strong masculine boy with a lovely rich overall colour. Head a broad moderate wedge with rounded contours. Level bite but his chin could be a little stronger. Wide-set cupped ears that could be a little larger & large eyes of good shape & set. Muscular & elegant body with limbs & tail to balance. Short fine & close-lying coat with even black ticking on a rich apricot base. A shy boy who preferred to hide under his blanket though not a problem to handle.

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN ADULT, FEMALE**

**1<sup>ST</sup> CC EVAN'S GLENDAVAN CORRYVRECKAN (23) F 10.02.09**

A lively girl of 14 months who looks younger than her age. Head a fraction long & a touch fine on the muzzle, she needs to mature. Slight nose break in profile, level bite and good chin. Large well-set cupped ears & large expressive eyes of a lovely deep amber colour. Her body is rather long and needs to muscle up. Straight back & elegant neck & limbs. Long tail that could be thicker at the base. Beautiful coat, short fine & close-lying with black ticking on a rich apricot base. Faint well-broken necklet & slight inner leg barring on the front limbs. Darker spine line, black tail tip and short black heels. Good head markings though creamy-white on her muzzle. Shown in lovely condition, a nice girl who just needs to mature.

**BLUE ABYSSINIAN ADULT, FEMALE**

**1<sup>ST</sup> (CC & BOB WITHHELD) WHITWORTH'S SILVERSMOKE CORNFLOWER (23c) F 08.07.09**

A young girl & only just an adult but of a good weight for her size. Lovely overall colour, a soft warm blue with beige underparts & mushroom base coat on the body. Head out of balance at present, a moderate wedge with rounded contours but I would prefer more of a nose break in profile, her chin slopes away and her muzzle could be broader. Cupped ears set wide apart but they could be larger. Large oval eyes set on a slant. Muscular body of medium build & size with limbs & tail to balance. Short fine & close-lying coat, blue ticking though it could more distinct. Lovely pale markings around the eyes but the pencil markings could be more defined. Darker spine line, blue tail tip & unmarked chest. Shown in lovely condition & easy to handle. Too many faults at present to justify the certificate & hopefully she will improve as she matures however her colour is a great asset for a breeding queen.

**BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL ADULT, MALE**

**1<sup>ST</sup> CC HENDERSON'S ADINOSH REMUS (76 30) M 15.04.09**

A young boy of not quite 12 months but well-grown, strong & muscular. Broad masculine head, a medium wedge with rounded contours & well-developed jowls. Large nose & broad muzzle with quite pronounced whisker pads and large slightly puffed nose leather. Concave curve to the profile & rounded chin, his bite appeared to be level but I only had a brief glimpse as he wasn't keen on having it checked. Relatively small ears with a broad base & set wide apart. Oval eyes of a pale green colour but set a touch straight. Powerful body, long & sleek with strong limbs but his tail is a touch long and tapers a little. Lovely rosetted coat pattern with doughnut spots on the body with a dark outline and paler centre. Warm golden base coat. Soft

coat of medium length that could be more luxurious, possibly changing at present as not such a clear pattern down his back. Spotted tummy, ringed tail and lovely clear leg markings.

**BROWN SPOTTED BENGAL ADULT, FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> CC & BOB AUST'S BUNDLEBENGALS MIDNIGHT (76 30) F 29.06.09

A young girl of only 9 months with a fantastic temperament and beautiful coat pattern that looked as if it had been painted on! Head longer than wide with a broad muzzle & pronounced whisker pads. Very slight concave curve to the profile. Medium ears with a broad base, set wide apart and held forward in profile. Large eyes of a good green colour, oval in shape and set on a slight slant. Long body with medium length limbs, the hind ones longer. Medium length tail of even thickness, bony tip. Short dense & close-lying coat with a luxurious feel to the touch. Distinct spotting though some linkage on the shoulders. Spotted tummy, ringed tail and well-marked limbs. A lively girl with lots of personality and a pleasure to judge.

**SNOW SPOTTED BENGAL, ADULT MALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> (CC & BOB WITHHELD) CRUTCHLEY'S TOBYSDEN YOGIBEAR (76b 30) M 07.06.09

A young blue-eyed boy of only 10 months but very well-grown and strong & muscular. Broad masculine head slightly longer than wide with a large nose, broad muzzle and pronounced whisker pads. Good profile & level bite but his chin slopes away a little. Wide-set ears with a broad base & rounded tips but they are a little large at present. Large oval eyes of a lovely deep blue colour. Long muscular body with muscular limbs to balance. Medium length tail of good thickness but unfortunately he has a fixed deviation approximately 2 cm from the tip. Soft dense coat with large rosetted spots on an ivory base. Good head markings with long lines on the cheeks & complex scarab marking. Spotted tummy. Certificate withheld because of the tail otherwise I would have been happy to give it. Such a shame!

**USUAL ABYSSINIAN KITTEN, FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> & BOB EVANS'S GLENDAVAN CAPERCAILLE (23) F 07.10.09

A young girl of 7 months of a good weight for her size though she could be a little larger overall. Nice head, a moderate wedge with rounded contours. Slight nose break in profile, shallow but acceptable chin and level bite. Large ears, cupped & pricked and set wide apart. Large expressive eyes of rounded almond shape tapering to a rounded muzzle via a slight indentation. Elegant body with a straight back with slender limbs & relatively large oval feet at present. Tapering tail to balance. Short fine & close-lying coat of a lovely rich overall colour with black ticking developing on an apricot base. Creamy-white on her chin & nostrils. Darker spine line & black tail tip. Fuzzy necklet, just about broken with a hint of a gap; I hesitated over the award but gave her the benefit of the doubt. Shown in lovely condition and easy to handle.

**SORREL ABYSSINIAN KITTEN, FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> & BOB DESOLLA'S NISHALKA KIYA (23a) F 06.11.09

A well-grown girl of only 5 months of a good weight & substance and developing nicely. Head a moderate wedge with rounded contours and tapering via a whisker indentation to a rounded muzzle. I would prefer a little more nose break in profile, what she has is mainly due to the presence of a nose bump. Level bite but her chin is

shallow and could be a little stronger. Large cupped ears set wide apart & expressive eyes of good shape & set though they could be a little larger. Elegant & muscular body with limbs to balance & oval paws. Long tail with good thickness at the base. Dense close-lying coat of a lovely warm overall colour with chocolate ticking developing well on an apricot base. Faint broken necklet, darker spine line and chocolate tail tip. Shown in lovely condition with a sweet gentle nature.

### **AV FOREIGN BREEDERS ADULT, FEMALE**

*A quality class.*

1<sup>ST</sup> CAUNTER'S CH THICKTHORN MADRAS (73b) F Chocolate Ocicat

A beautiful mature girl of 2½ years with a lovely coat. Head a modified wedge longer than wide with a broad squarish muzzle that is longer in profile & gentle curve from muzzle to cheek. Slight dip in profile, good chin & level bite. Moderately large ears with a broad base & gently rounded tufted tips set a fraction close but held at the correct angle of 45°. Large green eyes of almond shape & angled slightly upwards towards the ears. Strong & muscular body with good bone development & muscular limbs to balance. Fairly long, slightly tapering tail. Lovely coat, short close-lying and sleek with a satiny texture that emphasises the spotted pattern. Distinct chocolate spotting on a pale copper agouti base. Good head markings with dark lines on the cheeks. Tabby "M" extending over the top of the head & breaking up into small spots on the shoulders. Larger well-spaced spots on the body with a bull's eye pattern on the flanks & broken spine line. Well-marked limbs, spotted tummy and ringed tail with a dark tip. Shown in excellent condition. A strong wriggly girl with a gentle nature.

2<sup>ND</sup> CHERKAS'S GR CH JUSARKA THAI LILAC PROMISE (34) F Korat

3<sup>RD</sup> PENFOLD'S CH KWANSAN NUTIKITA NALA (77) F Singapura

A petite girl of just 2 years with a lovely coat. Good head face on with a rounded skull & rounded width at outer eye level, definite whisker break and short broad muzzle. However her profile is almost straight and her chin could be stronger. Bite not checked. Large cupped ears set slightly wide of parallel. Large wide-open green eyes. Lithe & muscular body of medium length & firm. Elegant limbs & small oval feet. Slender tail to balance. Short fine & close-lying coat clearly ticked with sepia brown on an ivory base with a soft warm overall colour. Unmarked chest & underparts apart from a faint broken necklace. Long cheetah lines on the face. Inner leg barring on the front limbs, very faint knee bars and dark spurs on the hind legs. Shown in beautiful condition. A gentle girl though not keen on having her bite checked.

### **AV FOREIGN BREEDERS KITTEN, FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> MAPES'S KARAKUL POTTY DOTTY (33a 20h) F Devon Rex

A well-fed chocolate tortie girl of 8 months with a large tum! Broad head but not much stop in profile. Large ears with small tufts, set low but rather close together & her eyes could be more expressive. Loosely waved coat with some guard hairs & could be softer. A gentle girl who was easy to handle.

### **AV FOREIGN NOVICE NEUTER**

1<sup>ST</sup> HUTCHINSON'S KIMANI RASTA OF IRREP (72) MN Bombay

A strong muscular boy of 13 months with a lovely coat. Head a slightly longer wedge with a slight nose break in profile. Well-set ears and expressive pale gold eyes.

Rather long body with elegant limbs & tail. Short fine & close-lying coat of jet black with a glossy sheen and good colour to the roots. Excellent condition and temperament.

**2<sup>ND</sup> WELSH'S AMEEKA PIED HARRIER (73 41) FN Ocicat Classic**

A sweet young girl of only 9 months but very well-fed with a large tummy! When she relaxes she has the typical wild look. Head a modified wedge slightly longer than wide with a square muzzle that could be a little longer in profile & very slight dip to the profile. Level bite & deep chin that rounds off slightly at the tip. Moderately large ears set at an angle of 45° with good width between them. Almond-shaped eyes angled slightly upwards but they could be a little larger. Long body of a good weight for her size but her large tummy spoils the lines. Muscular limbs and long, slightly tapering tail. Close-lying coat with a lustrous sheen but could be a little more satiny in texture. Dark brown markings on a tawny agouti ground with good butterfly & oyster markings on the body. Broken necklaces on the chest, barred limbs and ringed tail with a dark tip. A gentle girl shown in lovely condition.

**3<sup>RD</sup> LOWELL'S MEGGYMOO DANTE'S INFERNO (33 36) MN Cornish Rex**

**AV SOCIALITE NEUTER**

**1<sup>ST</sup> FOULKE'S AMEEKA BLAZE-OF-GLORY (73 41b) MN Chocolate Ocicat Classic**

A large well-grown boy of only 9 months with a strong muscular body. Head a modified wedge slightly longer than wide. Gentle curve from muzzle to cheek, his muzzle is longer in profile but could be a little squarer. Slight dip to profile, level bite & deep chin that slopes away a little. Large well-set ears with a broad base & rounded tips and good width between them. Large almond-shaped eyes set wide apart and angled slightly upwards towards the ears. Excellent body, long & muscular with an athletic appearance. Muscular limbs to balance & long slightly tapering tail. Lovely coat, short & close-lying with a satiny texture. Distinct classic pattern with chocolate markings on a pale copper agouti ground though could match a little better, the left oyster is a little blurred compared with that on the right. Spotted tummy, barred limbs and ringed tail with a dark tip. A gentle boy shown in super condition.

**2<sup>ND</sup> DEAN'S AMAROGUE MORRIS MINOR (84 31) MN Sphynx**

A large boy of 2½ years. Head a modified wedge slightly longer than wide. Scissor bite and his chin could be stronger. Very large ears with a broad base and rounded tips & set at a slight angle. Large lemon-shaped eyes. Well-grown body, hard & muscular with a rounded abdomen and chest & limbs to balance. Long fine tail. Short fur on his nose but elsewhere the desired peachy effect due to very fine down. A very gentle boy shown in good condition.

IMP GCC CHERKAS'S GR CH JUSARKA THAI LILAC PROMISE (34) F

A very pretty girl of 2½ years with a sweet gentle nature. Lovely heart-shaped head with typical Korat look & beautiful eyes. Slight stop in profile & her tip of her nose drops off. Level bite with lovely teeth though her chin could be a fraction stronger. Good width between & across the eyes and well-developed muzzle. Well-set ears & large expressive eyes of a bright green colour. Semi-cobby body of a good weight for her size with elegant limbs and small oval paws. Tapering tail of medium length with a heavy base. Single close-lying coat of an even blue colour with silver tipping, especially on her legs and paws. Excellent condition & temperament. A lovely start to the day!

#### **KORAT LIMIT ADULT**

1<sup>ST</sup> BLACK'S MOEI LALANA (34) F Korat

A young girl of exactly 9 months; her eye colour and silver tipping need to develop. Head basically heart-shaped but her muzzle is a little fine. Well-set ears and well-opened amber eyes that could be larger. Well-grown body with elegant limbs and medium length tail. Short fine & close-lying coat of a dark blue colour.

#### **KORAT NON-BREEDERS NEUTER, MALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> EVANS'S GR PR MAIPENRAI DOWJAI (see Short-Haired CS)

2<sup>ND</sup> OZIMKOWSKI'S THEOAKS GEORGE (34) MN Korat

A big strong boy of 12 months, only young but very well-grown with a powerful body. Heart-shaped head with good width between & across the eyes & rounded muzzle. Well-set ears and large green eyes with a rounded aperture but they could be more wide open. Muscular semi-cobby body with limbs & tail to balance. Single close-lying coat, glossy & fine with silver tipping developing. A vocal boy with lots to say but OK to handle.

3<sup>RD</sup> DAY'S MAIPENRAI LILAC FOXGLOVE (34c) MN Thai Lilac

#### **KORAT NON-BREEDERS NEUTER, FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> DAY'S UK & IGR PR MAIPENRAI TAO PRINCESS (34) Korat

A mature girl of 6 years with lovely type. Heart-shaped head with good width between & across the eyes gently curving to a rounded muzzle. Well-set ears and expressive green eyes. Strong muscular & semi-cobby body with elegant limbs & medium length tail that is heavier at the base. Short, quite fine and close-lying coat of an even blue with a well-developed silvery sheen. Lovely overall balance, a gentle girl shown in super condition.

#### **KORAT VISITORS NEUTER**

1<sup>ST</sup> DAY'S PR MAIPENRAI DOC FLOWER (see Short-Haired CS)

2<sup>ND</sup> DAY'S MAIPENRAI LILAC FOXGLOVE (34c) MN Thai Lilac

A large, very strong boy of nearly 6 years. Heart-shaped head with good width between & across the eyes. Slight stop in profile & his nose drops off at the tip but his chin could be stronger. Large ears & well-opened eyes of a clear pale green colour but they could be larger. Semi-cobby body with elegant limbs & medium length tail. Short fine & close-lying coat of a warm pinky-beige with good silver tipping on the head & limbs but slightly gingery on the body. A gentle boy who was easy to handle.

##### **AV CORNISH OR DEVON REX GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> (IMP GCC WITHHELD) DESOLLA'S UK & IGRCH INDASIA MIRISKIA (33 36a) F 28.05.03 Cornish Rex

A mature blue smoke girl on not quite 7 years. Typical Cornish look, head a medium wedge narrowing to a rounded muzzle with high cheek bones & an almost straight profile. Deep firm chin and level bite though only a few incisors remaining. Large ears set rather high & medium eyes of oval shape. Long neck & very elegant, muscular body of medium length & carried high on long legs with small oval paws. Quite long, tapering tail. Short silken coat well-rexed with tight ripples apart from a broad band down her back of thinner, straighter fur. Very gentle nature & easy to handle. I was sorry to withhold the Imperial certificate as she has always been one of my favourite girls but her coat wasn't at its best on the day.

##### **AV NON-BREEDERS ADULT, MALE**

1<sup>ST</sup> MURRAY-DREW'S ASPIRITOUS URIAH HEAP (79S 16) M Selkirk Rex

A super blue boy of not quite 12 months. Excellent type & strong muscular body. Lovely coat, dense and well-covered with loose individual curls giving the desired soft plush feel. Easy to handle & shown in excellent condition. I remember admiring him as a kitten at the Rex Cat Club show in November & it was a privilege to be able to judge him today. My cat of the day.

##### **ANY LAPERM KITTEN**

1<sup>ST</sup> CRAGG'S WAKANDA OOZE THAT CURL (80L) F

A very well-grown girl of 6 months. Nice head, a modified wedge with gentle contours & broad muzzle. Large cupped ears and almond-shaped eyes that could be a little bigger. Muscular body of medium size with limbs & tail to balance. Large

rounded feet. Lovely coat with a springy texture & not harsh, lovely colour too though no points for this. A gentle girl shown in lovely condition.

2<sup>ND</sup> NICHOLS'S AMORCATZ LIZZIE DRIPPING (80S 27hx) F

An older girl of 8 months & of a good size for her age. Head a modified wedge though her muzzle could be a little broader and she has a nose bump in profile. Well-set ears & almond eyes set on a slight slant. Muscular body of medium build with limbs & tail to balance. Wispy coat that is a little harsh to the touch. Attractive chocolate tortie colouration with darker points.

#### **AV DEBUTANTE NEUTER**

1<sup>ST</sup> HOPKINS'S IKURIKAT SATCHMO (33 36) MN Cornish Rex

A very elegant black smoke boy of 12 months. Head a medium wedge but he is a little pinched at present with a rather square muzzle. Almost straight profile. Large ears set rather high & oval eyes of medium size. Muscular body carried high on long straight limbs & long fine tail. Lovely coat of a silken texture & well-rexed with tight ripples on the body.

3<sup>RD</sup> LOWELL'S MEGGYMOO DANTES INFERNO (33 36) MN Cornish Rex

A sweet baby girl of only 4½ months with lots of developing still to do. Nice type, head with a rounded skull & rounded width at outer eye level. Definite whisker break & short broad muzzle with a blunt nose. Slight stop in profile. Level bite. Well-set, quite well cupped ears but perhaps they could be larger at this stage of her development? Reasonably large eyes that are set wide open, the colour developing. Body of medium build & length with limbs to balance & slender tail. Fine, close-lying coat with sepia ticking on an ivory base, overall colour rather cool at present. Dark outline to the eyes & short cheetah lines. Pale salmon nose leather with a complete dark outline. Unmarked underparts, faint well-broken necklace. Inner barring on the front limbs but back knees unmarked. Brown spurs on the back legs and dark tip to the tail. Shown in lovely condition and easy to handle.
